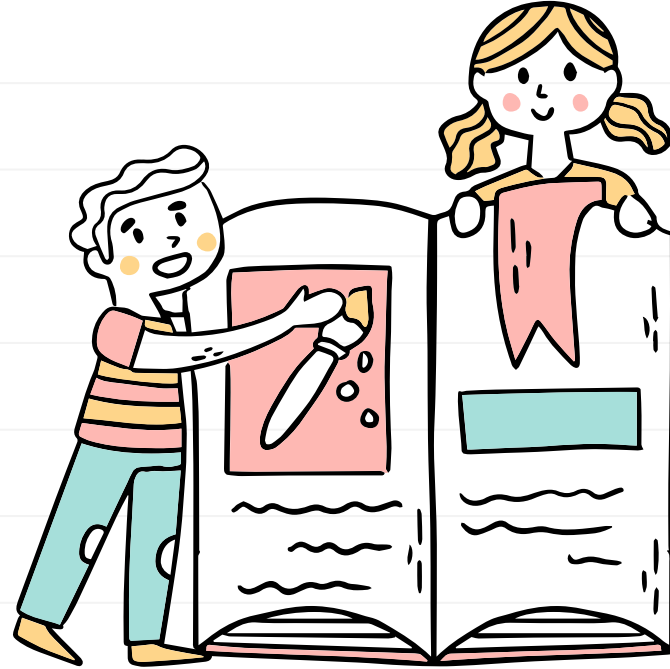


**THE NEWTON

Classes run 9:00-1:30pm, with with breaks for snack and lunch.

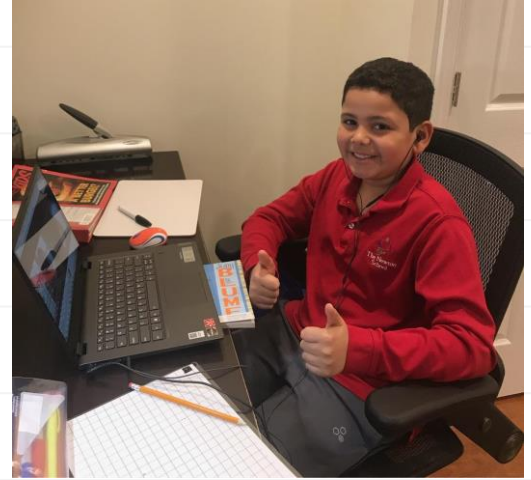
Homework assigned Monday – Thursday in reading and math.

All implemented via Google Classroom and Meet.

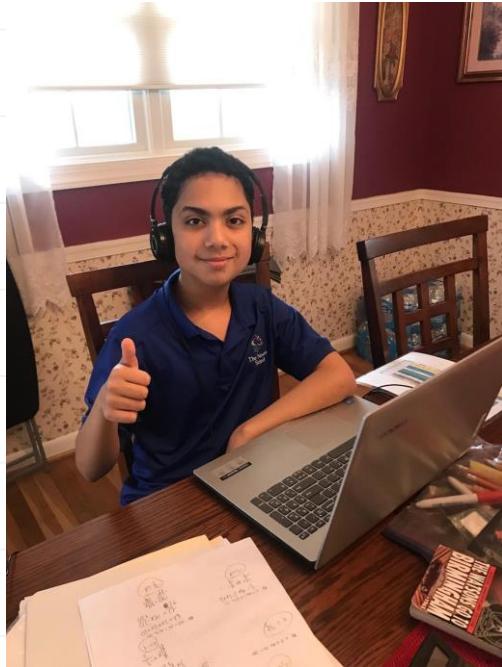
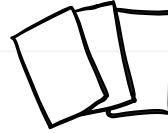
